Established in 1993, The Enhanced Life Options Group is a New Hampshire non-profit trust management organization serving individuals with special needs. Many of the corporation's directors have a person with disabilities in their family. The Enhanced Life Options Group is a 501(c)(3) public charity, bonded to the maximum allowable amount and audited annually. No minimum or maximum asset balance is required to be eligible for services. Services are available to individuals regardless of the specific type of disability.

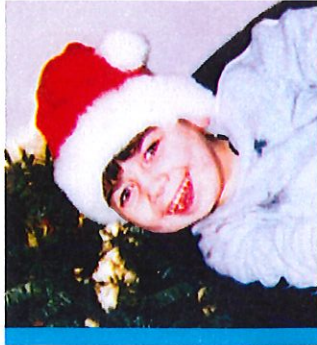
